RE: STARTING GO-DEVIL ENGINES IN COLD TEMPERATURES

We always recommend to our customers that when purchasing a Go-Devil for use in cold temperatures they purchase an electric start model. The reason being that the colder the temperature the thicker the grease becomes in the shaft housing, therefore, it will make it harder to pull start a Go-Devil.

In any event with any model Go-Devil, in very cold temperatures a little starting fluid sprayed in the air intake will help the engine start much easier. Warn your customers to be very careful and not to use excessive amounts of starting fluid. We also recommend to use our Go-Devil grease which is a #1 grease (lighter) and also use a lighter synthetic oil such as a 5W20.
